

Begin: Formalities for the submission of the Master Thesis

You are expected to submit three copies of your thesis: one each goes to the two reviewers, one remains in the exam office. Please also forward a PDF file of your thesis to the exam office for the LSI theses electronic archive. This should be done before or on the day you plan to submit your thesis.

Each copy should be properly bound with a cover, soft cover is fine. For the title page, the following text can be utilised:

All of this should be nicely distributed over the page, in centred style. Then a table of contents should follow, after that the text, properly formatted (either in Word or LaTeX), pages numbered. A bibliography follows the chapters proper as a first appendix (more if appropriate).

At the very end there should be a separate page with the confirmation the MPO expects you to provide:

"I herewith certify that this material is my own work, that I used only those sources and resources referred to in the thesis, and that I have identified citations as such."
